Formula Inches Pulled x Pounds per Inch + Dead weight Divided by weight of tractor

Guidelines:

1. All pulls will be by percentage of weight.
2. Pull will be in small to large order. If track is wet, will pull larger tractors first. (Even year small tractors pull first and odd year large tractors pull first.)
3. 2 hooks per tractor.
4. \$10.00 hook fee per hook.
5. Maximum Speed of 3.5 MPH all classes.
 - a) If driver exceeds speed limit after marker they will be disqualified
 - b) If driver is flagged and does not stop they will be disqualified
 - c) Horn on sled is set to go off when speed reaches 3.6 mph.
6. Age of tractor 1959 and older.
7. Gasoline-Diesel-distillate-Kerosene-Propane will be allowed. Any hot fuels or special mixes not allowed Will be protested. The judges may protest any tractor for use of "hot fuel" and disqualify that tractor.
8. As these are percentage pulls, pulling "Out the Gate" doesn't distinguish the winner. Therefore, "out of the gate" tractors will have to re-pull and have the option of highest percentage.
9. Foul or abusive language will be grounds for disqualification.
10. Tractors shall be stopped if front end raises higher than 18" off the ground. A device will be used to determine the height. If a tractor uses wheelie bars the driver must have the wheelie bars set so that the front of the tractor can only raise 18" of the ground. It will be the responsibility of the driver to show proof of proper setting.
11. Tractors without wheelie bars will have a height chain attached.
12. Draw bars: minimum length of 18 inches both classes.
 - a) Height on classic tractors, 20 inches maximum
 - b) Height on farm stock tractors, 18 inches maximum.
 - c) If a hole in drawbar is used to pull from, it must be 3 inch diameter, other wise pull will be by clevis.
 - d) No pulls allowed by trailer hitch ball.
13. Weight must be securely fastened. Front weights can go no more than 11 ft. from center of rear axle.
14. If anything falls off tractor while on the track it will be disqualified.

15. Drivers must follow proper safety guidelines.
16. Standard R.P.M. for the model of the tractor.

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17. Tire size:
 - a) 15.5-38, maximum for 14" rim on row crop tractors.
 - b) 16.9-34 up to 6500 lbs.
 - c) 18.4-38 over 6500 lbs.
 - d) Cut tires allow in classic classes.
 - e) No Cut tires on Farm Stock classes.
 - f) No weights on farm stock classes.
18. All tractors must have working brakes.
19. Farm stock classes pull in low gear.
20. Farm stock classes pull 3.0 MPH
21. No locked Differentials in any class.
22. No power Shift or Torque amplifiers allowed.
23. No turbo Chargers. Except (Oliver 99 GM or Related MF or JD 435 or Factory Detroit engines).
24. Decision of the judge is final.
25. NO ALCOHOL to be served or consumed on the grounds of the Ozarks Steam Engine Association.
